

<b>Peterbald</b>													
<b>Body</b>	<p>The medium sized, elegant cat is slender and muscular. The body is elongated and lithe. The rib cage and shoulders are not wider than the hips.</p> <p>The legs are long and slender, the front legs are straight and the paws are dainty and oval with long toes (monkey fingers).</p> <p>The tail is very long, thin at the base, whippy and ends in a pointed tip.</p> <p>The neck is long and slender.</p>												
<b>Head</b>	<p>The head is wedge-shaped. The wedge starts at the nose and broadens on both sides in straight lines to the ears.</p> <p>The nose is long and straight, the forehead is flat. The profile is slightly convex.</p> <p>The muzzle is fine, with a strong chin, forming a vertical line with the tip of the nose.</p>												
<b>Ears</b>	<p>The ears are very large with a broad base and pointed. They are wide set, with the outer edges continuing the sides of the wedge.</p>												
<b>Eyes</b>	<p>The eyes are almond-shaped and set slightly at a slant to the nose, in harmony with the wedge-shape of the head.</p> <p>The colour is a bright green. In the Colourpoint the colour is an intense blue, the darker the better.</p>												
<b>Coat</b>	<p>The skin is soft and supple, totally naked or covered with a slight down.</p> <p>There are numerous wrinkles on the head, less on the body.</p> <p>Whiskers are desired.</p> <p>Hairless cats are preferred.</p>												
<b>Colour varieties</b>	<p>All colours and patterns are recognized. Any amount of white is permitted. The description of colours is listed in the general list of colours.</p>												
<b>Faults</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• missing wrinkles on the head</li> <li>• front legs not straight</li> <li>• extremely fine bone structure</li> </ul>												
<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mating with other Sphinx is forbidden. Mating with Siamese, Balinese, Oriental Shorthair and Oriental Semilonghair is permitted.</li> <li>• In kittens, the legs, paws, tail and muzzle may be covered with slight coat, which should be absent in adult cats older than 2 years.</li> </ul>
